Reed and Murkowski Release Draft of FY 2013 Interior, Environment, and Related Agencies Appropriations Bill

Washington, DC – The bipartisan leadership of the Senate Appropriations Subcommittee on Interior, Environment, and Related Agencies today released draft text of FY2013 legislation that provides funding for America’s National Parks, invests in clean air and water, and protects our nation’s fish and wildlife.

Statement of Senators Jack Reed (D-RI) and Lisa Murkowski (R-AK), Chairman and Ranking Member of the Interior, Environment, and Related Agencies Appropriations Subcommittee:

“Today we release the Chairman’s mark of the Fiscal Year 2013 Interior, Environment, and Related Agencies Appropriations Bill. While Congress has passed a short-term continuing resolution, we hope this final draft document will serve as a roadmap as discussions continue to finalize a responsible, balanced fiscal year 2013 appropriations bill. We will continue working together, with our colleagues and our House counterparts, to turn this draft into law.”
